- Online payments you can check your student's account at any time. You can pay for field trips & extracurriculars, as well as pre-pay for Pizza Days, Subway, milk & ice-cream cards and yearbooks.
- Online demographics updates this is our mandatory annual verification that all of the information we have on file for your child is correct. The government requires this information so that our funding matches our student population. Please if you have not already completed this in School Engage, do so ASAP.

For high school our first semester is coming to a close. We have three weeks before exam week which happens the last week of January. As we are gearing up for this home stretch to final exams at the end of the month, we ask parents to assist their children with balancing work, school, friends and extracurricular activities so that they have the best chance of successfully finishing their courses.

In Chinook's Edge, we know that creating a positive social-emotional culture in our schools will significantly impact the well-being and achievement of both students and staff. We care deeply about this priority and the entire division is engaged in creating SEW supportive classrooms. Social Emotional Well-being (SEW) has been a key divisional goal for us for several years.

Under the direction of Dr. Marcie Perdue, Associate Superintendent of Student Services, Chinook's Edge has developed a series of training sessions for school leaders, teachers and support staff. The focus of these sessions is to promote universal social emotional strategies, such as focusing on the classroom environment and using visuals to support classroom routines. The training also focuses on the importance of developing emotional vocabulary and self-awareness. The strategies are being shared through training to all division staff who work directly with students: teachers, educational assistants and school administrators. A highlight of the training sessions was recognizing key characteristics which capture the most impactful social emotional classroom environment.

This determined focus, to bring social emotional well-being supports to life in every school, will help students and staff reach their full potential. When everyone in our school communities are met each morning knowing they are welcome, safe, cared for and respected, they are more open to learning, leading and succeeding.

Winter Break Extended For Students until January 10, 2022

As you may be aware, the Alberta government has announced a <u>provincewide</u> <u>extension of the winter break</u> for Kindergarten to Grade 12 students until January 10th. This means there will be no student learning throughout next week and this includes access to online learning.

We know this announcement may create childcare challenges for some families, and we thank you for accommodating this government priority to reduce the spread of the rapidly spreading Omicron variant and to allow school jurisdictions time to prepare for their newest reality.

In light of the changing pandemic, this coming week, our staff will be working to ensure they are fully prepared to support face-to-face learning, and if necessary, temporary online learning in some or all of our schools beginning on January 10th. Please note that all in-person co-curricular and extra-curricular activities, including athletics, are paused until January 10, 2022.

When students return to school on January 10th, we are anticipating that the Government of Alberta will provide high-grade medical masks and rapid tests kits for each student and staff member that will be available for distribution. Details on the current state of Covid-19 in Alberta are available on the provincial government website.

As always, we appreciate your support as we navigate the latest phase of the pandemic. We do wish you a safe, healthy, and happy New Year, and we will provide updated messaging to you later next week as it becomes available.




