October was a busy month in the world of Career Exploration at Cremona School. Grade 10 to 12 students received presentations from the University of Lethbridge and Calgary. We had to postpone the presentations from Mount Royal, SAIT and Lakeland College due to the combination of missed instructional time and overall student apathy towards the presentations. I hope everyone had a chance to check out some of the post-secondary Open Houses that were taking place all over the province in October. SAIT's Open House is happening on November 3rd and 4th.

Dual Credit

Our Olds College Dual Credit students are in full swing. This year we have 3 students in the upper level welding course and an astonishing 16 students taking the introductory welding course. We also have 8 very dedicated students taking either Animal Health Technician, Sports Management or Marketing courses through the Online Dual Credit program.

Grade 9

The Grade 9 students have established what type of learning style suits them best and created beautiful posters outlining study tips that correspond with their learning style. They are currently completing interest / skill surveys that will match them with potential career choices. They will then choose a career that interests them and create a presentation about that career.

Grade 12

We have all had our first 1 on 1 interviews outlining graduation requirements and future aspirations. During these interviews I gave each of your children a post-secondary handbook and or a trades handbook, which outlines the process on how to apply to a post-secondary institution. I also provided each student with a scholarship handbook which outlines how to write a personal essay and lists copious amounts of available scholarships. **Please push your kids to apply to as many scholarships as possible.** Free money is always a great thing!!

In November, we will be conducting our second round of 1 on 1 interviews. **The hope is that EVERY Grade 12 student has a concrete plan for next year,** whether that be post-secondary, seeking employment right away or traveling the world.

Grade 10 & 11

Individual interviews will take place for Grade 10 and 11 students closer to the end of the first semester.

Band Society Update




Please join us at our next meeting on Wednesday, November 1st at 7:00pm in the library. We look forward to seeing you there!


Cremona School Enhancement Society
