  - Julia shared a successful model of before and after school care within school with an independent contractor operating
  - If there is an independent contractor who is interested Darryl suggests connecting with Melissa and Shawn Russel (Associated Superintendent for Facilities)
  - Some locals drive their students to other schools due to the lack of before and after school care in Cremona.
  - Could it be used as work experience opportunities for interested students? Credit for CPR for example could count.
  - New Pizza supplier being considered from Olds Panago pizza Motion to reimburse Anna for the pizza to come out of the Pizza Day SGF account Seconded by Sarah.
