

CRAIG LERBEKMO & KAREN SINCLAIR



Information for Registration

We have a rich play based program that offers fun learn through play experiences for 3 and 4 year olds. For example; hatching chicks, sessions with a local music therapist, connecting with local seniors groups for Valentines and home school groups to watch play performance. We also play outdoors daily, learn our letter sounds, numbers and letter recognition, pre printing skills and cutting, read stories, sing songs, play instruments, daily crafts, work on yoga and mindfulness, learn important social skills like turn taking, listening skills, independence skills, how to follow directions and be a kind friend.

Classes follow Rocky View School Divisions Calendar on Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday from 9:00-11:30 and Friday mornings from 9:00-12:00. Fridays are geared towards our 4 year olds who will be attending kindergarten the following fall.

Children may be enrolled for 2 day, or 3 day per week program. Children must be 3 years old by September 1st, 2024 in order to register. If your child isn't 3 by this date but will be within our school year (Sept-May) you have options. Please reach out if you are interested.

We are a part of the Alberta Child Care Subsidy Program which allows our fees to be reduced by \$75 per child a month.

The fees you are required to pay for 2024/2025 are as follows: **\$38.00/month for the two day program or \$79.00 for the three day program (Sept-May).**
