Creating this account will also give all our students access to Apply Alberta, which is the exclusive website used for applying to post-secondaries within our province.

Grade 12 Parents: We are almost finished with our Grade 12 meetings where we discuss plans for next year. Some have applied to post-secondary, some are pursuing the Trades, some working then college for 3 months, and some feel taking a year to decide is the right decision. For those students who want to attend post-secondary but are not sure which one, I have suggested applying to both and then deciding in a couple of months.
